JOINT LEGISLATIVE RESOLUTION

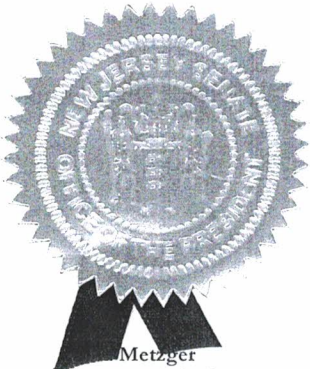
